- In Mozambique, Africare's support for oilseed production and processing in four districts more than doubled farmer incomes and reduced stunting of children under age 6 by 60 percent.
- In Burkina Faso, thanks to Africare's growth monitoring program for severely malnourished infants, 80 percent gained up to 1.2 pounds in only 12 days.
- Post-harvest losses fell by over 30 percent in Uganda and food availability increased by 40 percent, resulting in a seven percent reduction in the stunting of children between the ages of two and six.

This is wonderful progress, but there is still so much more to be done. That is why Africare has positioned itself to be "The New Africare in a New Africa."

Through this monumental initiative, Africare has rededicated itself to helping Africa by building on our past successes and core strengths, which achieves results like creating a comprehensive and fully integrated HIV/AIDS treatment approach.
